For more than 20 years, Tryon Presbyterian Church has supported children from our sister church, El Mesias.

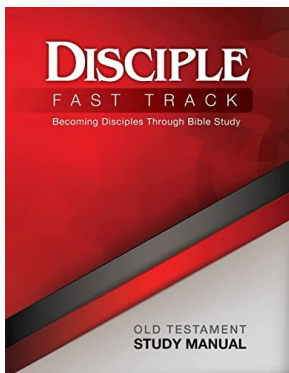
